Opening Prayer: Lord, help me to see what Your will is for my life. Amen.

INTRODUCTION

There is nothing more important than knowing and doing God's will. Success is knowing the will of God and being right in the center of it. Consider this while discussing the following questions:

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS: *The focus – discern God's will for our lives.*

1. Pastor Tracy said God's will is not a feeling. Explain what this means.
2. Pastor explained God's will is not a formula. Why would God not want to have a set formula to His will?
3. We make mistakes often. However, that does not disqualify us from His will. What joy do you find in this truth?
4. Pastor Tracy informed us not to be fatalistic about God's will. Two reasons were because it is unfair to God and it is unhealthy to us. Explain why these are true.
5. Why should we not be fearful about God's will for our lives?
6. Why should we not be frustrated about God's will?
7. **Read 1 Timothy 2:3 - 4.** The starting point for knowing God's will is establishing a relationship with Jesus. Why is this vital for knowing God's will for our lives?

THINKING FORWARD

Spend time seeking God and discover why you should not be afraid or frustrated with what He is calling you to do. Our mistakes do not disqualify us, but God does qualify the called. What does He want you to do so that all people can discover, develop and do life with Jesus?

VERSE TO GO

This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. (1 Timothy 2:3-4)
